Dates: Saturday, August 29 at 9:00am through Sunday, August 30, 5:00pm (Overnight)

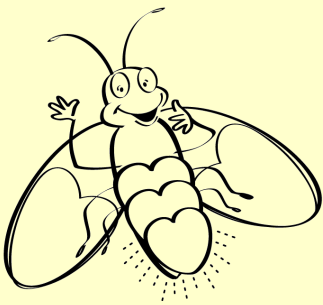
Place: YMCA of the Pines, Medford NJ
